Lesson Plan	Digital Design & Development Basics Training Module for Deaf Youth Duration: ~60 minutes (3 topics × 20 minutes) 1. Reviewing the Learning Journey (20 minutes) Objective:

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	- Encourage participants to reflect on their progress and key takeaways. Main Points to Cover: • Overview of Modules 1–9. • Discussion on personal growth and challenges. • Sharing of best moments and successes. Activity: • Individual reflection sheet + group sharing session. Teaching Methodology: • Visual mind map + group discussion.
	2. Presenting Final Projects (20 minutes) Objective: - Allow participants to demonstrate what they have learned. Main Points to Cover: • Presentation of digital projects (e.g., simple app, design, or code). • Constructive feedback from peers and trainers. • Emphasis on communication and creativity.

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	Activity: • Mini “Digital Fair”: each group presents their work. Teaching Methodology: • Presentation, peer review, and applause moments. 3. Next Steps and Future Opportunities (20 minutes) Objective: - Help participants plan how to continue learning and applying their skills Main Points to Cover: • Pathways for further education (online courses, Erasmus+, internships). • How to build a digital portfolio or CV. • Staying connected in the Deaf Young Code community. Activity: • Create a short “action plan” for personal or professional development. Teaching Methodology: • Interactive guidance + visual worksheet + motivational discussion.
